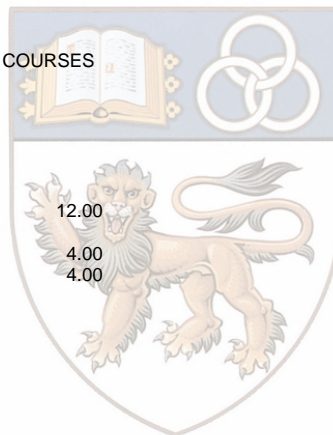

#### **SUPPLEMENTARY EXAMINATION AND RE-EXAMINATION**

Students who sit for Supplementary Examination or Re-examination (if applicable) are awarded the grade appropriate to the marks they obtain.

#### UNITS

Units measure the academic workload of a student. One (1) unit corresponds to 2.5 hours of study and preparation per week in a regular semester, so a 4-unit course requires 10 hours of work per week, including classes, assignments, and self-study.

#### GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA)

The Grade Point Average (GPA) tracks the academic progress of a student. It is the weighted average grade point of all courses taken by the student, unless specified otherwise. Courses with no assigned unit or grade point are excluded from the calculation of the GPA.

#### GRADE-FREE SCHEME (GFS)

The Grade-free Scheme (GFS) provides up to 32 units of Satisfactory /Unsatisfactory (S/U) option to support undergraduate students in making a successful transition to university life. If the S/U option is exercised on a course, its grade will not be computed towards the GPA. Course units will be recognised towards the degree if an “S” grade is attained, and will not be recognised if a “U” grade is attained.

#### LEAVE OF ABSENCE

Only leave of absence of one semester or longer is recorded in the transcript.

#### DEGREE CLASSIFICATION

#### **FACULTY OF LAW – DEGREE CLASSIFICATION**

(a) The criteria for degree classification applicable to students admitted to the Bachelor of Laws (LLB) degrees from AY2025/2026 are as follows:

Degree Classification	Criteria
First Class Honours <sup>(4)</sup>	Obtained a Grade Point Average for all courses taken in Law that is equivalent to a grade of A- or better, and finished in the top 20% of the graduating class.

Degree Classification	Criteria
Second Class (Upper Division) Honours <sup>(4)</sup>	Obtained a Grade Point Average for all courses taken at NUS that is equivalent to a grade of B or better, and do not qualify for First Class Honours.
Second Class (Lower Division) Honours	Obtained a Grade Point Average for all courses taken at NUS that is equivalent to a grade of C or better, and do not qualify either for First Class or Second Class (Upper Division) Honours.
Third Class Honours	Completed the number of units required for a LLB (Honours) degree but do not qualify for First Class, Second Class (Upper Division) or Second Class (Lower Division) Honours.

(4) A student will not be eligible for First Class or Second Class (Upper Division) Honours if:  
(i) the student has failed more than 12 units of courses at NUS (or while on an approved exchange programme); or  
(ii) the student has taken more than 9 semesters to complete the 4-Year LLB programme (excluding periods where the student has been granted leave of absence).

(b) The criteria for degree classification applicable to students admitted to the Juris Doctor (JD) degrees from AY2025/2026 are as follows:

Degree Classification	Criteria
JD (Highest Distinction) <sup>(5)</sup>	Obtained a Grade Point Average for all courses taken at NUS that is equivalent to a grade of A- or better.
JD (Distinction) <sup>(5)</sup>	Obtained a Grade Point Average for all courses taken at NUS that is equivalent to a grade of B or better.
JD (Merit)	Obtained a Grade Point Average for all courses taken at NUS that is equivalent to a grade of C or better.
JD	Completed the number of units required for a JD degree but do not qualify for JD (Highest Distinction), JD (Distinction) or JD (Merit).

(5) No student admitted in and after AY2024/2025 will be eligible for JD (Highest Distinction) or JD (Distinction) if:

- (i) they have failed more than 12 units of courses at NUS (or while on an approved exchange programme); or
- (ii) they have taken more than 7 semesters to complete the 3-year JD programme or 5 semesters to complete the 2-year JD programme (excluding periods where the student has been granted leave of absence).
